

Regulations of participation in Design talks Business part of Gdynia Design Days 2018

§1

General information

1. Regulations specify the rules for participation in events organized as part of the Gdynia Design Days 2018, the festival organized by the Pomeranian Science and Technology Park Gdynia - Design Center, a budgetary unit of the City of Gdynia, with headquarters in Gdynia at Al. Zwycięstwa 96/98, PPNT Gdynia – Design Center, hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.
2. The aim of events organized by the Organizer is to develop skills in designing, transforming and implementing projects based in the field of contemporary forms of design.

§2

Rules of a participation in events

1. Events organized as part of Gdynia Design Days 2018 are open.
2. The events are addressed to all interested in the matter subject, including students, graduates, PhD students, freelancers and entrepreneurs.
3. Prior registrations are required for the event via the application form available on the website www.evenea.pl.
4. The person registering for the events will receive confirmation of being entered on the list of participants or entering the reserve list, if the number of disposed is higher than the number of available places.
5. At the latest two days before the planned date of the event, the Organizer will ask the persons entered on the list of participants, to request or to confirm participation in the event. Lack of confirmation may result in deletion from the list of participants.
6. A person under 18 years old can participate in events only with the consent of legal guardians.
7. The organizer reserves the right to change the date of events without giving a reason. Information about the change of the date will be sent by e-mail to the address indicated by the Participant during registration.
8. The Participant is obliged to:
 - behaving in a way that does not threaten the safety of other Participants, in particular to comply with health and safety regulations, fire regulations and the provisions of these Regulations,

- adhere to the instructions of the Organizer and the security services.
9. The organizer reserves the right to remove the Participants from the events, who behaving:
 - threatens the safety of other Participants,
 - disturbs order and infract generally accepted norms of behavior in public places,
 - infract the principles of personal culture and disturb other Participants from receiving events.
 10. The organizer reserves the right to refuse to take part in an event to people under the influence of intoxicants, mind-altering substances or alcohol.
 11. The Participant transfers copyrights to the Organizer, including the right to consent to the pursue of dependent copyrights to the effects of works created during the events, referred in art. 2 and art. 46 of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights in all fields of exploitation referred to in art. 50 of the Copyright and Related Rights Act 1994.
 12. The Participant agrees that the copyrights to any modifications and adaptations (including the right to use them and dispose of them) will be the sole propertyship of the Organizer in all fields of exploitation referred to in art. 50 of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights 1994.
 13. The Organizer has the right to retain works created during the Event, contentst in working versions, 3D files, photo files and text files regardless of the form of their *perpetuate*, whose ownership is transferred free of charge to the Organizer at the end of the events.
 14. In the event of a someone else (third-party) claiming against the Organizer income with infringement of copyrights or personal rights of third parties related to the work resulting from work during the events, the Participant will pay the costs and pay compensation related to claims of such persons.
 15. Without prejudice to the rights of the Organizer, the Participant may publicly invoke and present works created during events in a territorially and temporally unlimited manner.

§3

Admissions

6. The Organizer reserves the right to remove from the list of participants in the event of failure to pay the admission within the specified time.
7. It is not possible to pay for participation on the event site.

§4

Resignation

1. It is not possible to resign from participation in the event after registration and payment.
2. The Participant has the right to give his ticket to a third party after informing the Organizer about this intention by the e-mail sanded to address: e.chudecka@ppnt.gdynia.pl, at latest one week before the planned event.

3. In case of changing the date of the event, the Participant is entitled to a refund costs of admission.

§5

Responsibility and compensation

1. The Organizer does not insure event Participants and is not liable for: loss, loss, damage to equipment, clothing and other items belonging to the Participant.
2. The Participant of the event is liable if the Organizer suffers losses as a result of his negligence.
3. If losses are found, the Organizer will create appropriate documentation together with a repair cost estimate, then make repairs according to the cost estimate, a copy of which will be sent to the Participant's address. The Participant shall cover in full the costs of removing the damage within 14 days from the date of delivery of the debit note.
4. Persons who have been entered on the list of participants of the event are entitled to a refund of the cost of participation in the event due to the cancellation of the event.
5. In order to receive a refund of the cost of participation due to the cancellation of the event, the Participant will request a written form with an appropriate request to the Organizer. In this request, the Participant will also indicate the bank account number to which the Organizer will refund the cost of participation.
6. The Organizer will return the cost of admission to the Participant within 30 business days from the date on which the event was to take place.
7. The refund of the admission shall cover all claims of the Participant.

§6

Final Provisions

1. Participation in events means:
 - accepting these Regulations;
 - processing of the Participant's personal data in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016. on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on a free matter
 - granting gratuitous permission for recording, photographing, filming or other recording of the Participant's image, and for transmitting, distributing or showing this image and voice in connection with promotional and information activities carried out by the Pomeranian Science and Technology Park and the Gdynia Design Center. The participant is not entitled to any claims against the Organizer in this respect.
2. The Organizer is not responsible for the effects of force majeure. The higher power is in particular: atmospheric conditions, failures or disruptions in the operation of electrical energy supply devices.
